## **How to fill in the form Application for recalculation of sickness compensation if you are working. Resident abroad (sliding deduction)**

Please use this form if you have already received a decision on full or partial sickness compensation that applies for the time before 1 July 2008. Sickness compensation is not to be time-limited but permanent.

### **2. What year does the application apply to?**

State the calendar year for which application applies. A calendar year starts on 1 January and ends on 31 December. An application must be submitted for every calendar year.

### **3. Information about estimated total income from your country of residence**

You must add up all your pensionable income that you have received or will receive during the calendar year. This means that you must also include small and occasional income. All amounts shall be before tax (gross).

Income from another country than Sweden includes income which would have been pensionable if you had received it in Sweden.

Examples of pensionable income that you must include in your combined income

- wages from employment
- income from self-employment
- income from assignment as a special representative, contact person or attendant
- fee component if you are a foster parent
- fees from political or voluntary work
- fees as a member of a board or association
- sickness benefit

Examples of income that you should not include in your combined income

- sickness compensation
- parental benefit at the minimum level
- occupational injury annuity
- childcare allowance
- income from capital

### **4. Information about estimated total income from another country than your country of residence**

If you have several incomes, you must add them together and write down the total income before tax (gross). The amount shall apply to the period January to December this year. You must include all income that would have been pensionable if you had earned them in Sweden. Please see the examples in point 3 which may be of assistance.
